Subject:-Grant of permission to 04 Government Ayurveda Colleges of Maharashtra, for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder on the basis of submission affidavit dated 04.08.2026-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) This is with reference to the visitation of your college conducted **on hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process **the Permission for the academic session 2026-27, under Section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
- 2) Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations, namely, "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024", "Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under. **On careful examination of the assessment report and as per the Visitor Observation, various shortcoming/defects have been observed regarding Teaching, Non-Teaching, Hospital Staff, and Infrastructure.**
- 3) It is noted with serious concern that despite undertakings submitted by the concerned authority of State Government in previous academic years assuring the rectification of identified deficiencies within the stipulated time, the shortcomings still persist in your institutions.
- 4) In view of the above, the **Board decided to provide an opportunity of virtual hearing to appear before the designated Hearing Committee, to present their case and make oral submission.**
- 5) Thereafter, the observation of hearing committee on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing was duly placed in the **167th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 30.07.2026 and Board concluded that the colleges are not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and Regulations but decided to issue permission to the Govt. colleges of Maharashtra** subject to submission of affidavit (for the benefit of students) from the Principal Secretary/Secretary, Department of AYUSH & Director of AYUSH, Maharashtra regarding strict compliance and rectification of the shortcomings mentioned in the hearing letter on or before 31st January 2027 or if any shortcoming is found to persist during the evaluation of the Compliance Report or subsequent physical/virtual inspection/visitation by the Board the permission to Govt. Colleges of Maharashtra for conducting admissions for the Academic Year 2027-28 shall automatically stand withdrawn / denied in accordance with NCISM, Act 2020 & MESA&R Regulations, 2024.
- 6) Thereafter, an undertaking-cum-affidavit vide **no. EZ 870104 and vide no. EZ 870105 dated 04.08.2026 submitted by Mr.Raman Ghungralekar, Director of AYUSH, Directorate of AYUSH, Department of Medical Education and Drugs, Government of Maharashtra and Mr. Dheeraj Kumar, Secretary, , Department of Medical Education and Drugs, Government of Maharashtra respectively to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) ensuring that the deficiencies and shortcomings observed regarding Teaching, Non-Teaching, Hospital Staff, and Infrastructure shall be fulfilled on or before 31st January 2027.**

"DECISION"

- 7) Therefore, in view of above, permission to **04 Government Ayurveda Colleges of Maharashtra** is hereby granted which is as under :-

- a) **Extended Permission to Government Ayurved College, Tuljapur Road, Dharashiv, Osmanabad-413501, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0154) with intake capacity with 50 seats (63 Seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 48 seats (60 Seats including EWS) in 08 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Agad**

tantra-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya kalpana- 06 seats (08 seats including EWS)(iii) Kriya Sharir- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)(iv) Prasuti tantra & stri roga-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vi) Dravyaguna vigyan- 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) (vii) Rachna sharir- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (viii) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (07 seats including EWS).

- b) Extended Permission to R.A.Poddar Ayurved Medical College, Dr. Annie Besant Road, Worli, Mumbai-400018, Maharashtra (AYU0164) with intake capacity of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) and 45 seats (56 seats including EWS) in 13 PG Courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (ii) Rachna Sharir- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (iii) Kriya Sharir-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (v) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (without EWS) (vi) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan-03 seats (with EWS) (vii) Swasthavritta & Yoga-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (viii) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka-01 seats (02 seats including EWS) (ix) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga-05 seats (without EWS) (x) Kayachikitsa-08 seats (10 seats including EWS) (xi) Panchakarma-06 seats (without EWS) (xii) Shalyatantra-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (xiii) Shalakya Tantra-04 seats (05 seats including EWS){Shalakya Netra roga-02 seats and Shalakya Karna, Naasa & mukha-03 seats}.
 - c) Yearly Permission to Government Ayurved College & Hospital, 26/1, Gulabrao Deokar Engineering Campus, Mohadi, Shirsolli Road, Jalgaon-425002, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0592), with intake capacity of 100 seats (125 Seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS).
 - d) Yearly Permission to Government Ayurveda College and Hospital, Baramati, at post- Medad, S.No. 414/1, Morgaon Road, Baramati, Dist. Pune-413102, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0744) with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course.
- 8) The aforementioned decision is issued under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled:-
- (i) Minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity in UG (BAMS) course & PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- 9) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
- 10) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 11) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 12) **Compliance with all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 13) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31stJanuary, 2027 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-28 :-**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iv) All the requirement of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standard of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
- 14) The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.

- a. The College shall submit Affidavit in the prescribed format as per Academic Council's Resolution No. 229/2013 (format attached).
- b. For those UG / PG qualifications that are not yet recognized by the Central Govt., it shall be mandatory for the College to apply to the Central Council / Commission through Central Govt. and ensure that "Permitted" / "Not Recognized" qualifications are enlisted in "Recognized Qualifications", failing which University shall not grant Continuation of Affiliation to such courses from ensuing Academic Year and no student shall be admitted in such courses.

(vii) **Settlement of University Dues:**

"If your College fails to settle the advance amounts received from the University's Examination Department, Student welfare Department & other departments or fails to submit the Utilization Certificate by 31/12/2026, punitive action shall be taken against your College or the Continuation / Extension of affiliation for the upcoming Academic Year 2027-28 will not be granted by the University."

(viii) Other Conditions:

- 1) This Continuation / Extension of affiliation is issued for the A.Y. 2026-2027 subject to the permission of NCISM and / or Government of India. Further, if the permission is declined by the said authorities, this Continuation / Extension of Affiliation shall be treated as cancelled. The College is not authorized to admit students for 1st Year of the course until receipt of permission of the NCISM and / or Government of India.
- 2) The admission shall be done through the Competent Authorities only.

(IX) IMPORTANT NOTES FOR STRICT ADHERANCE:

- a. The College shall comply with all the provisions of the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act, 1998, the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations, Directions, and all applicable norms, regulations and guidelines issued by the concerned Central Council/Commission, the State Government and the University from time to time.
- b. Grant of Continuation / Extension of Affiliation for the Academic Year 2026-27 shall not confer any vested right upon the College to claim Continuation/Extension of Affiliation for subsequent academic years. Each proposal shall be considered independently in accordance with the prevailing statutory provisions and regulatory norms.
- c. The University reserves the right to conduct inspection(s) of the College and its attached teaching hospital at any time during the academic year to verify compliance with statutory provisions and regulatory norms.
- d. Failure to rectify the deficiencies within the stipulated period shall render the College liable for appropriate action under the provisions of the MUHS Act, 1998, including withdrawal or refusal of Continuation/Extension of Affiliation, reduction of intake capacity or any other action deemed appropriate by the University.
- e. If any information, declaration or document submitted by the College is found to be false, incorrect, misleading or suppressed at any stage, the Continuation/Extension of Affiliation granted under this order shall be liable to be withdrawn without prejudice to any other action permissible under law.
- f. No student or institution shall claim any equity or special consideration on the basis of admissions made in violation of the provisions of this order or any applicable statutory provisions.
